

Hanzaki Souvenirs

In 1955, the Hanzaki Grand Shrine Preservation Society was established by local volunteers, who organized the maintenance of Hikoshiro Mitsui's grave and the opening of the Hanzaki Festival.

Around this time, "Hanzaki-ya," a small souvenir shop, sold many Hanzaki-related goods, from *manjū* (steamed yeast bun with filling) to paper-mâché figures, to spinning tops.

However, half a century ago these souvenirs ceased production, and only the "Hanzaki-ya" sign on the street remains today.
